RESOLUTION 2021-06

Establishing a Policy to Allow Water Deliveries to Common Deliveries upon Deposit of Security and Establishing an Assessment Security Account

WHEREAS, the East Columbia Basin Irrigation District (District) is contractually obligated to collect assessments prior to delivery of water through a delivery report to the United States Bureau of Reclamation; and

WHEREAS, the subdivision of land has created "common deliveries" for multiple parcels served from one delivery point location; and

WHEREAS, a unpaid assessment by any parcel in a "common delivery" renders the delivery point to be designated "not clear" to receive water delivery under District policies; and

WHEREAS, a delivery point being declared "not clear" restricts delivery to all parcels, including those that have paid, which creates an inability for paid lands to beneficially use their allotment of Columbia Basin Project water supplies; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to create a policy that allows a landowner to deposit security in the amount of the delinquent assessments of the other accounts associated with the landowner's common delivery into a District assessment security account in order to "clear" the delivery point for water delivery to the paid lands; and

WHEREAS, the deposit in the assessment security account shall become a credit to the land that deposited security for the delinquent assessment following the District's receipt of the delinquent assessment through payment or foreclosure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the East Columbia Basin Irrigation District that landowners in a common delivery may clear their water delivery by providing the District with security in the amount of any delinquent assessments due on the other accounts included in the common delivery;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Assessment Security Account is established to hold the security deposits provided by landowners to clear their water delivery under a common delivery;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt of payment of the delinquent assessments for which a security deposit was made, the District shall apply the assessment security as a credit against the account of the land that deposited the security;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interest earned by the Assessment Security Account is to be retained in that Fund.
