**RESOLUTION 2025 – 02**

**REQUIREMENTS FOR Municipal and Industrial Contract Water Deliveries from OGWRP Delivery Systems**

**WHEREAS**, landowners have requested to receive Municipal and Industrial (M&I) water deliveries from OGWRP delivery systems, and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that M&I deliveries will be allowed from OGWRP delivery systems, subject to the following conditions:

- Any M&I contract charges due to the District, established on a per volume basis, shall be based on an equivalence of 3 acre-feet per acre.
- The M&I contractor shall pay OGWRP development costs in a manner that is equitable, by acre, with other lands to be served by the OGWRP delivery system.
- The M&I contractor shall pay in advance of design or construction all costs associated with the design and construction of the pipes, valves, flow meter, etc., required for the requested M&I diversion.
- The M&I contractor shall pay in advance of design or construction the full construction debt service charge for all 30 years.
- The M&I contractor shall pay their share of easement acquisition costs in a manner that is equitable, by acre, with other lands to be served by the system. Any easement acquisition costs shall be paid in full upon invoice by the District.
- There will be no adjustments or refunds in future years if the OGWRP construction debt service charge is reduced.
- The M&I contractor remains responsible for annual costs in accordance with ECBID policy for M&I contracts, including operation and maintenance costs, meter fees, and any other applicable fees as determined by the District.
- M&I contracts will remain the first deliveries to be interrupted if delivery constraints require interruption or rationing within the OGWRP delivery system or the District.
